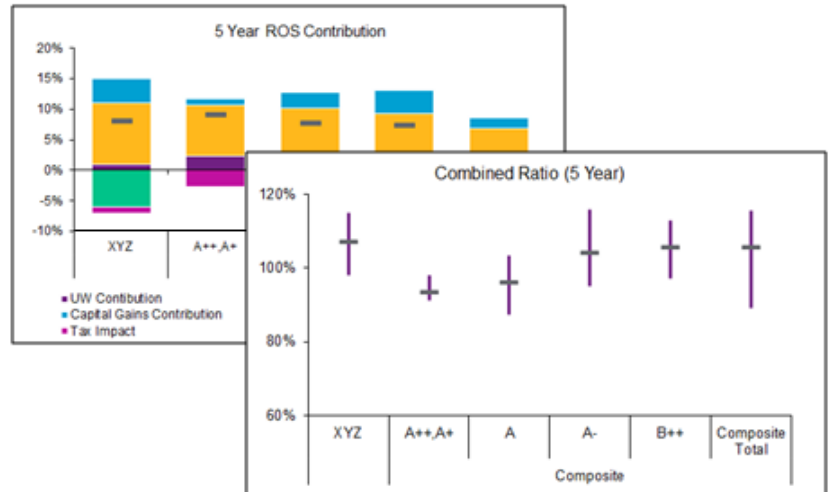
What is ratings benchmarking?
